You can proceed with creating your designs. If your designs do not print perfectly, your design is likely misaligned.

For designing with **Canva**, here are some common problems and solutions:

Design too large

If your design does not fit within the labels, your PNG template is likely too large for the page. Double click on it and resize it.

Design not aligning

Ensure your Canva design is of the correct size (A4). Also ensure the PNG template fits the page perfectly.

After downloading your Canva design, do a visual comparison with Page 2.

Set the Right Paper Size

These labels are of **A4 Size**. When printing your designs, ensure Page Size is set to **A4**.

Use the Right Scale

When printing PDFs, ensure the scale is set to 100%.

Check your Printer's Alignment

Over time, printers can become misaligned. Your printer should have a function to do an alignment test.

Repeat **Step 2.** To conserve labels, you can do test prints on unwanted paper instead and measure them together.
